Armstrong Atlantic State University's Office of Financial Aid is required by Federal Regulations to monitor the progress of aid recipients. To receive aid at Armstrong Atlantic State University, a student must maintain a satisfactory grade point average, make progress toward their degree objective and successfully complete their undergraduate degree within the maximum number of hours allowed (186 attempted semester hours). Based on our records you have not met one or more of these requirements. Please explain in detail why you have not made satisfactory progress in the coursework you enrolled in during the last academic year. **You must attach a legible well-written explanation and supporting documentation that corresponds to the dates for which you were not making satisfactory academic progress.** Please note that the appeals process takes 2-4 weeks. Once the committee has reviewed your appeal you will be mailed a Satisfactory Academic Progress Agreement. This agreement must be signed and returned in order to complete your file. If you fail to comply with the agreement or your aid is denied, you will be required to pay for a minimum of 12 semester credit hours at Armstrong Atlantic State University and pass all hours with a grade of **C** or better. Students who have attempted more than 186 hours and have not earned a bachelor's degree may not reinstate in this manner. **Priority deadline for submitting an appeal for the Fall Semester is June 19, 2009. If your appeal has not been reviewed and approved by the fee payment deadline, you MUST pay tuition. There is no guarantee your appeal will be approved.**

*Note: If the Standard of Academic Progress Committee determines that your explanation is not credible or finds a lack of supporting documentation, the appeal will be denied and will not be reconsidered until the student amends the submission. Students who have been granted an appeal in prior years are subject to closer scrutiny as repeat violators.*
